



Corporate Environmental Policy Statement

Regional and Northern Maintenance Services Pty (**RANms**) has responsibilities under the NT Waste Management and Pollution Control (Administration) Regulations 2004 to operate in a manner that supports the protection of the environment and prevents pollution. **RANms** has adopted International Standard ISO14001:2004 as a model on which to base its Environmental Management System (EMS).

RANms plans its activities and conducts them to ensure that adverse environmental impacts are avoided or kept within acceptable levels and meet all statutory requirements.

This Policy has been developed to demonstrate **RANms** commitment to environmental management and to support the environmental expectations of its customers and market areas.

To demonstrate this commitment and deploy this Policy, **RANms** will:

- Comply with environmental management laws and regulations applicable its operations and wherever possible adopt the highest possible standards,
- Apply contractual specifications or industry best practice if legislation or regulations do not exist,
- Participate actively with industry, government and other parties in the development of appropriate legislation and regulations,
- Review and update the EMS to reflect developments or changes in technology, legislation, industry practices, the company and/or community expectations,
- Measure, review and improve practices to reduce identified significant environmental impact to practicable and acceptable levels,
- Develop and audit EMS processes and procedures and integrate them with other management systems including Quality and Occupational Health and Safety
- Seek reductions in energy use and production of waste,
- Assess the potential effects of new or current Company activities on the environment and take appropriate action to prevent or minimise problems or promote solutions,
- Develop and maintain contingency procedures in order to manage and investigate any environmental incident,
- Ensure the need for environmental management and protection is promoted to employees through communication and training,
- Ensure contractors understand and conform to this Policy.

The Board of Directors will periodically review the status of the EMS and ensure adoption of objectives based on this Policy. Compliance with this Policy and its implementation is required of all **RANms** employees.

Operational control and reporting on the EMS has been assigned to the **RANms** QHSE Manger on behalf of the Board of Directors.
